
Oral Assignment (Audio)

What is an oral assignment?

An oral assignment is designed to assess your ability to pronounce key terms, engage with your client and demonstrate the critical knowledge and skills in your own words. This form of assessment usually takes 20 minutes depending on your course or qualification.

What could I be expected to do?

The oral assignment will contain a minimum of one (1) of the following types of oral assessments outlined below. To confirm which oral assessment type you will be required to complete please refer to the subject outlines.



Submitting your oral assignment

Your oral assignment forms part of your overall assessment and is uploaded through your KapLearn subject room. You'll need to submit the following at the same time:




You'll be required to submit your oral and written assignment within the timeframe outlined in your study plan.

What you will need

You'll need to have access to one (1) of the following devices:
